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Tips

• **Know your audience.** Before you start writing, think about who will be reading your paper. Are they experts in the field? Are they students? This will help you decide how much detail to include and what language to use.

• **Use clear and concise language.** Avoid jargon and technical terms unless you are sure your audience will understand them. Use simple, direct sentences and avoid unnecessary words.

• **Organize your paper logically.** Start with a clear introduction that states your purpose. Then, present your arguments in a logical order, using headings and subheadings to organize your text. End with a strong conclusion that summarizes your findings.
